Honours Degree Requirements.

- To complete an Honours Degree in Interactive Arts and Technology, the following is required:

- All of the standard requirements for a Bachelor's degree in Interactive Arts and Technology (either B.A. or B.Sc. with any of Media Arts, Design, or Informatics as a concentration).
- Additional upper division IAT coursework to bring your total IAT course credits in the upper division to 48. IAT 490-6 and IAT 491-6 must be a part of these 48 credits.
- The Honours Research Project Sequence: IAT 490-6 and IAT 491-6.
- A total of at least 60 upper division credit hours (including 48 IAT credits) must be completed.
- An overall total of at least 132 credits must be completed, between major requirements, honours requirements, and electives.
- A Cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.0 or higher is required to be in the Honour's program.
- An Upper Division Grade Point Average is required to be in the Honour's program.
- Students must find a professor as supervisor for their Honours project.

Application Process

- To apply for the Honours Degree in Interactive Arts and Technology

1. Ensure you have read the requirements located at left.
2. Contact one of your professors regarding your interest in pursuing an Honour's Research Project. If the professor is interested in taking you on as an Honour's student, proceed to step 3. Faculty biographies can be viewed at www.siat.sfu.ca/faculty
3. Contact the SIAT Advisor at siat_advising@sfu.ca to ask for an application form.
4. Complete the application form and contract in conjunction with your faculty supervisor and return to the SIAT advisor.
